July/Aug.

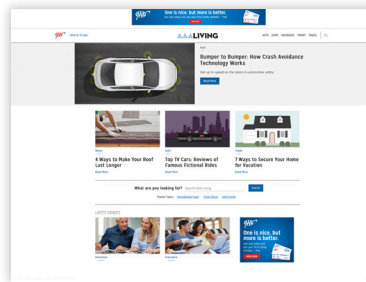
Day Trip Itinerary: Bemidji (lake town getaway with parks, nice downtown, lots of Diamond-rated hotels and restaurants)
